The addressee LHW Young was the Colonial Manager of the Falkland Islands Company (FIC) from 1929 to 1936, based in Stanley, and the Managing Director 1936 to 1958, based in London. [His successor was Frank Mitchell.]

The cover was carried from Grytviken to Stanley by the FIC owned SS Lafonia, which had set out from Stanley on 30 October 1937 and returned via Montevideo, principal port and capital city of Uruguay on west coast of South America on 20 November, arrival and departure dates at South Georgia are not known.

South Georgia's only post office was located at Grytviken, which was where the FI government had established the administrative centre of South Georgia.
